Daily tasks-reading, CLIC and phonics.

Reading practise:

- Read for 10 minutes each day.
- Ask your child questions about the text.
- Can you talk about the book? Who were the main characters, what is the setting, what was the problem, how did the story end, which was your favourite part and why?

CLIC:

- Count in 2's, 5's, 10's and 1's form any given number backwards and forwards within 100.
- Recognise three digit numbers such as: 305, 112, 586, 917, 430
- Learn the following calculation facts: half of 18 is 9 because 9+9=18
 half of 16 is 8 because 8+8=16
 half of 14 is 7 because 7+7=14
 half of 12 is 6 because 6+6=12
- What would 90+90 equal? (you could hide the 0 and solve 9+9 then add back the 0 to the answer) How about 80+80, 70+70, 60+60,

Phonics:

Every day practise spelling the following tricky words correctly: once, different, eyes, many, please. Can you get them all right by Friday?

- Day 1 collect words with **ph** digraph and have a go at writing them down: elephant, phonics, phone, dolphin, alphabet (write a sentence with one of the words)
- Day 2 teach children that when the v is at the end of a word, it is always accompanied by e and we write them down as ve. Collect and record words that end in ve (v sound): give, have, love, dove, glove (write a sentence with one of the words)
- Day 3- collect words with <u>eigh</u> and have a go at writing them down: eight, weight, sleigh, neighbour, neigh (write a sentence with one of the words)
- Day 4 collect words with x and have a go at writing them down: mix, fox, exciting, exam, exactly (write a sentence with one of the words)
- Day 5 Sentence writing with the sounds we have covered during the week. Tell children sentences and ask them to have a go writing them down by themselves.
 (I have eight cars. My neighbour always likes to wear a pink glove. The elephant weighs a lot. I have learnt the alphabet. I give lots of food to the doves. Father Christmas has a sleigh. I will take an exam on Monday. I like to mix and stir the cake mixture.)
