

Literacy learning overview

This week your child should create a travel/holiday brochure for a seaside holiday in the past. If your child has not completed the history tasks yet then they may find this activity challenging and you should encourage them to do the tasks first. Your child should imagine that they work for a travel company in the past (around 100 years ago) and they want to encourage people to come and visit the seaside. They should create their own travel/holiday brochure giving information about why people should visit the seaside and what they can do when they get there.

The success criteria is therefore...

- **I can think about my knowledge of seaside holidays in the past.**
- **I can use titles, headings and pictures.**
- **I can use adjectives and different sentence types.**

Your child can decide how they wish to present their brochure. They can type it up on the computer, use the template given on our website or make their own template. It's up to them!

The activities are...

- To complete the seaside holiday comprehension task.
- To look at examples of different holiday brochures to get ideas.
- To create their own holiday/travel brochure about a seaside holiday in the past (around 100 years ago).

This is your child's last literacy task of Year 2 and it should be a chance for them to get creative and have fun as well as apply their historical knowledge that they have learnt this term!

Thank you so much for your continued work at home with your child.
