2. Labeling our new waste caddies

3. Next steps in improving paper recycling

Ideas to raise awareness for paper waste at school:

- rubbing out mistakes instead of scrunching up a piece of paper and restarting on a new piece
- a NO PAPER DAY to raise awareness for paper waste
